



Pursuant to existing Federal Laws and Regulations, individuals applying for or renewing their Airport issued badge, must present **valid** unexpired identity and work authorization document(s) as follows:

List of acceptable documents is attached to the most current Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, issued by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (see [www.uscis.gov/files/form/i-9.pdf](http://www.uscis.gov/files/form/i-9.pdf)).

- a. Documents(s) presented must include one with a photo per 49 CFR 1542.209(e)(3).
- b. U.S. Citizens born abroad or naturalized U.S. Citizens, will need to provide one document listed below in order to initiate the security threat assessment:
  - i. Unexpired U.S. Passport, or
  - ii. Certificate of Naturalization, or
  - iii. Certificate of U.S. Citizenship, or
  - iv. Certification of Report of Birth, Form DS-1350, or
  - v. Certification of Birth Abroad, Form FS-240, or
  - vi. Certification of Birth Abroad, Form FS-545

TSA personnel and non-LEO Federal employees must present their Agency identification media as identification verification and proof of authorization to work.

In order to successfully complete a transaction at the ONT Security Badge Office, individuals must present original documents and legible photocopies for each transaction, as required above.
