If the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is able to continue to fully implement, or can substantially implement, "contra flow" procedures at ONT during the project duration, or if airlines at ONT are able to modify their operations to reduce noise for departures during nighttime hours, then the project would be Categorically Exempt (Class 1 and Class 2) from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (relating to minor alterations to existing structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination), as well as under CEQA Guidelines Section 15302 (relating to the reconstruction of existing structures or facilities involving substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.)
